It is an infection spread by tick bites.



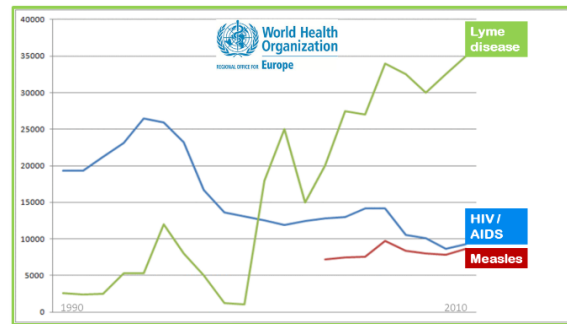
It attacks the nerves, brain, heart, joints, and eyes, and can also cause skin rashes and fevers.



Research suggests 1/3 or more of Lyme patients still have symptoms after antibiotic treatment, which can be permanent.



Lyme disease is spreading at 14% a year throughout Europe.

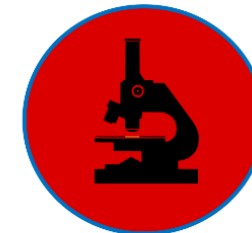


Lyme is Europe's commonest and fastest-spreading disease caught from biting creatures.
